EXTREME WEATHER (Hopefully not!)

In the event of a disruption to school caused by extreme weather (such as heavy snowfall) the prime concern of our school will always be the **health and safety of the pupils, parents and staff**. In keeping with our school policy, the decision to close the school will be made **before 8.30am** (where possible) and, if necessary, will be made **the night before** with an aim of providing working parents with more time to find alternative and suitable supervision for children. **PLEASE NOTE:** When a decision has been made to close the school, **the announcement will be made as follows:** 1. Firstly, by **text message** directly to parents using the school's messaging service (to mobile numbers previously provided by parents). 2. Secondly, **on the BBC News Website and Radio Ulster**. Parents should be aware that these BBC services require email confirmation directly from the school which includes a validation code and so, once announced, this can be taken as a formal school closure. However, it does take some time for the BBC website to be updated. **During severe weather, parents and staff should always check these sources before travelling to school.**




Teachers are currently updating ideas to help develop your child's Numeracy Skills. Please ensure you go over the maths ideas with your child each week.


